



Results of Member Surveys


Spring 2020, Fall 2020, and Fall 2021

Effect of COVID on Fall Enrollment




Effect of COVID on Budgets, Staffing, and Programs

- 68% of fall 2021 respondents reported no major change to staffing, up from 51% in fall 2020.
- 87% of fall 2021 respondents reported no change to program offerings, up from 76% in fall 2020.




Mode of Instruction and Clinical Placements

- All members reported resumption of clinical placements in fall 2021, and 80% of those placements were in-person.
- 87% of fall 2021 respondents reported contingency plans for clinical placements. These include changing schools/districts (60%), simulation (57%), and supplementary projects (51%).




Instructional Changes Due to COVID




State Policy Changes Due to COVID
