

Travel Price Index | October 2022

The Travel Price Index (TPI) increased by 2.5% in October (vs Sept.) while overall consumer prices (CPI) increased by 0.4%

- After three months of declines, gas prices increased in October (+4% vs Sept)
- Lodging fares increased by 5.6% while airfare decreased by 1.1%

On a year-over-year basis (YOY), TPI remained more inflated than CPI (+11.3% vs +7.7%)

• Most notably, airfare was up by 43% and motor fuel up by 18% However, the extremely high YOY airfare increase is largely due to the extremely low fares in October 2021, due to the Delta covid variant. When compared to pre-pandemic (2019) prices, airfare was actually less inflated in October 2022 (+9.1%) than overall CPI (+15.8%).
