


### **Project Summary**

The ESSN is a US\$246 million 3-year project that will provide cash transfers and access to **social services** to extreme poor and vulnerable Lebanese populations affected by the economic and COVID-19 crises. The ESSN aims to arrest the increase in extreme poverty and to preserve the human capital of 13 - 18 years old children enrolled in public schools. The ESSN also aims to build a sustainable national social safety net (SSN) system in Lebanon.

The ESSN will scale-up and enhance the National Poverty Targeting Program (NPTP): Lebanon's main poverty-targeting social assistance program launched in 2011 with financial and technical assistance from the World Bank.



### **Expanding Existing Systems**

The roll out of the ESSN project will allow to extend coverage from 1.5% to 20% of the Lebanese population

## **Selection of Beneficiaries**

- Proxy-Means Testing (PMT) methodology: poverty score calculated based on wealth, assets, and demographic characteristics
