Haupt Conservatory has been transformed into a botanical runway adorned with thousands of orchids and accessorizing plants, inspired by the creative visions of rising design stars Hillary Taymour of Collina Strada, Olivia Cheng of Dauphinette, and FLWR PSTL a.k.a. Kristen Alpaugh. Orchids, often hailed as the "divas of the plant world," have long inspired designers, and *The Orchid Show: Florals in Fashion* presents an extraordinary selection of these exquisite flowers, including rare specimens from NYBG's collections. Diverse plant species, from epiphytic cacti to carnivorous nepenthes, complement the orchids in displays of living attire, with each designer bringing a distinct perspective to the intersection of flora and fashion.
