The Bike Crossing

192 Old Town Crossing

In the heart of Ridgeland, this full-service bicycle shop offers a multitude of bikes, gear, and helpful tune-up and repair services. Stop inside the shop for maps or local recommendations.

Chisha Foka Multi-Use Trail

This 10-mile paved path runs through historic Choctaw homelands along the Natchez Trace Parkway. Enjoy the serenity of this protected greenspace with other cyclists, joggers, and nature enthusiasts.

Parkway Information Cabin

Natchez Trace Parkway Milepost 102.4

Upon entering the trail at The Bike Crossing, turn left. Get to know the area's Choctaw history and culture when you stop at the Natchez Trace Parkway Information Cabin. This building was once home to the Bill Waller Craft Center and currently offers restrooms open daily to the public.

Ridgeland Visitors Center

Renaissance at Colony Park

Begin your adventure along the pathways at Renaissance at Colony Park, in the warmer months, cool off with a stop into Scoop Dee Doo ice cream shop or Smoothie King.

Old Trace and Brashears Stand Site

Natchez Trace Parkway Milepost 104.5

Brashear's Stand is a historic trailhead featuring a boardwalk that leads to the current residence of the Bill Waller Craft Center, showcasing the work of the Craftsman's Guild of Mississippi and artisans across from members of the southeast.

Old Trace Park

422 Post Rd

You're sure to have some recreational fun along the scenic paths throughout Old Trace Park. Getting hungry? Choose from three of Ridgeland's signature dining spots at Madison Landing: Pelican Cove Grill, Cock of the Walk, and Crab's Seafood Shack.

Reservoir Overlook

Milepost 105.6

Enjoy the view from the trail's north terminus. Relax with a hammock or blanket while taking in the Barnett Reservoir. If you've brought some snacks with you, this is a beautiful spot to enjoy a break.

Township at Colony Park

1107 Highland Colony Pkwy

From the Ridgeland Visitors Center at Renaissance at Colony Park, navigate through "The Renaissance" to the stop light near BankPlus. Cross Highland Colony Parkway to access the designated bike route. Keep straight and follow W Parkway Place to Steed Road. Cross Steed Road, turn left, and follow the sidewalk to S Lake Avenue. You have arrived at "The Township", a master-planned, mixed-use community of shops, hotels, and more. In the cooler months, Fusion Coffeehouse offers coffee, hot chocolate, and a warm greeting before sending you on your way.

Township Ponds

Ride along the two sidewalk loops overlooking the ponds near Anjou restaurant and Soulshine Pizza.
