Subject: In Advance of SOTU, Health Care is an Albatross for Trump in Michigan Date: January 30, 2020

In advance of President Trump's State of the Union address next week, a new Public Policy Polling survey finds that health care is the most important issue or a very important issue for a large majority of Michigan voters (66\%) when deciding who to vote for in 2020. This issue is important to voters across party lines, including $65 \%$ of independents and $49 \%$ of Republicans, while just $1 \%$ of overall voters do not consider health care to be an important issue.

President Trump's decisions on health care issues are deeply unpopular among Michigan voters.

- The overwhelming majority ( $82 \%$ ) support allowing Medicare to negotiate for lower prescription drug costs with drug companies, which Trump has promised to veto. Just $6 \%$ of voters oppose ending the ban on Medicare negotiating drug prices.
- $72 \%$ of voters oppose President Trump's plan putting Medicare cuts on the table if he is re-elected-including by a plurality of Republicans, with $49 \%$ opposing his decision and only $42 \%$ in support.

Heading into the State of the Union Address, the results show a majority of voters do not trust President Trump's positions on health care. While Trump won Michigan in 2016, voters now trust Democrats more than President Trump on both the issue of pre-existing
conditions (53-41) and prescription drugs (52-44), two of the most important issues on voters' minds in 2020. When voters are given a choice between whether they think President Trump has improved health care for the American people or undermined health care for the American people, a majority (54\%) feel that the president has undermined health care for the American people.

Other key findings from the survey include:

- Only 30\% agree with President Trump's lawsuit to strike down the Affordable Care Act in the courts.
- Trump's effort to use the courts to eliminate protections for people with preexisting conditions is a major concern for $72 \%$ of Michigan voters, including $76 \%$ of independents and 55\% of Republicans.
- Similarly, the fact that 20 million Americans would completely lose their health insurance coverage if President Trump's lawsuit is successful is a major concern for $71 \%$ of voters, including $73 \%$ of independents.

PPP surveyed 376 voters in Michigan from January 23-24, 2020. The margin of error is +/$5.1 \%$. The survey was conducted by telephone on behalf of Protect Our Care.
