23	Section 101. Short title.	
24	This act shall be known and may be cited as the Pennsylvania	-
25	Gaming Economic Development and Tourism Fund Capital Budget	
26	Itemization Act of 2019.	

Τ	Section 102. Declaration of policy.
2	The General Assembly finds and declares as follows:
3	(1) The Pennsylvania Gaming Economic Development and
4	Tourism Fund is essential to the financial viability of the
5	Commonwealth and its political subdivisions.
6	(2) Chapter 3 authorizes project grants from the fund.
7	(3) It is necessary to make a conforming amendment to
8	Title 4 (Amusements) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
9	Statutes to properly administer project grants from the fund.
10	CHAPTER 3
11	AUTHORIZED PROJECT GRANTS
12	Section 301. Authorizations from Pennsylvania Gaming Economic
13	Development and Tourism Fund.
14	Grants for projects, including capital, debt and operational
15	expenses itemized in section 302 from the current revenues of
16	the Pennsylvania Gaming Economic Development and Tourism Fund by
17	the Department of Community and Economic Development, or its
18	successors or assigns, are hereby authorized pursuant to 4
19	Pa.C.S. § 1407 (relating to Pennsylvania Gaming Economic
20	Development and Tourism Fund) as specified in this chapter. The
21	total amount authorized to be financed under this chapter from
22	the revenues of the Pennsylvania Gaming Economic Development and
23	Tourism Fund shall be \$20,000,000.
24	Section 302. Itemization of Pennsylvania Gaming Economic
25	Development and Tourism Fund projects.
26	The projects to be financed from the current revenues of the
27	Pennsylvania Gaming Economic Development and Tourism Fund are
28	hereby itemized, together with their respective project
29	allocations, as follows:
30	Project

1 **Project Allocation** 2 (1) To a regional economic development corporation located in two contiguous counties ofthe third class where a city of the third class 4 is located in both counties of the third class 5 for debt service on the construction of a science 6 and education center in either of two contiquous-7 counties of the third class in which a city of 8 the third class is located in both counties and where a Category 2 licensed facility is located 10 11 in a city of the third class which is located in-12 more than one county of the third class. 20,000,000 13 (Base Project Allocation - \$20,000,000) 14 (2) (Reserved). Section 303. Duration of payments. 15 16 Notwithstanding any other provisions of law: (1) The amount allocated to the project described in 17 18 section 302(1) shall be paid in annual amounts of not lessthan \$2,000,000 for 10 years, subject to section 304. 19 20 (2) (Reserved). Section 304. Limitation on expenditures. 21 22 (a) General rule. Beginning in fiscal year 2019-2020, or 23 the first fiscal year in which the indebtedness described under-24 section 302 is incurred, whichever occurs later, it shall be 25 mandatory, not directory, that payments pursuant to section-26 303(1) shall be made each year from the Pennsylvania Gaming-Economic Development and Tourism Fund by the Department of 27 28 Community and Economic Development. 29 (b) Proportionate reduction. -- In any year that the

Department of Community and Economic Development determines for

- 1 any reason that there are not sufficient funds to make the-
- 2 mandatory payment, the amount of the mandatory payment shall be-
- 3 proportionately reduced in an amount equal to the shortfall in-
- 4 the Pennsylvania Gaming Economic Development and Tourism Fund.
- 5 (c) Total expenditures. Total expenditures under this
- 6 chapter for the projects referred to in section 303 shall not
- 7 exceed the total amount authorized for each project in section
- 8 302.
- 9 Section 305. Limitation on use of allocation.
- 10 No more than one tenth of 1% of the amount of a grant-
- 11 allocated under section 302 may be used for administrative costs-
- 12 incurred by the regional economic development corporation
- 13 described in section 302 for which the allocation was
- 14 authorized.
- 15 Section 306. Appropriations.
- 16 The sums necessary for the annual amounts itemized in-
- 17 sections 302 and 303 are hereby appropriated from the
- 18 Pennsylvania Gaming Economic Development and Tourism Fund to the
- 19 Department of Community and Economic Development, upon approval
- 20 of the Governor, for the projects itemized in this chapter.
- 21 Section 307. Reports and notification.
- 22 The Secretary of the Budget shall, within 10 days of the
- 23 expiration of each quarter of each fiscal year, electronically
- 24 provide to all members of the General Assembly a report relating
- 25 to the authorized projects described in section 302, and
- 26 authorized projects from the Pennsylvania Gaming Economic
- 27 Development and Tourism Fund through capital budget itemization
- 28 acts for years prior to 2019, which includes all of the
- 29 following:

- 19 PROVIDE TO THE CHAIR AND MINORITY CHAIR OF THE APPROPRIATIONS

- 30 THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.
